## **EVENT PAYOUT SCHEDULE 50/50 PURSE**

As a prize each class will have a purse generated from entries. Therefore the approximate prize would equal 50% of total entries for each respective class determined once registration closes @ 10:00a day of event and entries are calculated.

Top 3 finishers for each class will receive their respective portion of the 50/50 purse; 1st place 50%; 2nd place 35%; 3rd place 15% of determined class purse.

Awards and prizes announced at the Wake the Monster Awards Dinner held @ Sunset Bar & Grill W7905 High Ridge Rd. Fort Atkinson Wisconsin after the event.

## **EVENT RULES**

1. "The Wake the Monster" Ice Race Benefit is a charity event developed by Hooligan Racing to promote awareness and support for wounded veterans through [raceforthewounded.com](http://raceforthewounded.com). **While the event itself may be competitive in nature, all participants are encouraged to remember the true spirit of the event and greater cause.**
2. Participation in the event is at the sole discretion of Hooligan Racing and its managers.
3. All participants must register, sign and complete the event release form prior to participating in the event. Any rider found not to have properly registered and signed the release waiver will be immediately disqualified from the event and possibly from future events. No refunds will be given.
4. All team members must be declared in writing on the assigned Team sheet prior to start of the race. Teams are limited to (4) four riders. Teams who field more than the assigned riders and/or riders undeclared riding on their motorcycle will be immediately disqualified from the event. No refunds will be given.

5. No rider under the legal age of majority (18) may compete without the written consent of both his/her parents or legal guardians. If both parents are unable to attend the event then a notarized form must be completed and brought to sign-up. The parents, legal guardian, or authorized adult must remain present while the rider he/she is responsible for is participating at the meet.
6. Any individual or team who knowingly or unknowingly allows a rider on their team who has not properly registered will be disqualified immediately from the event and possibly from future events. No refunds will be given.
7. Only registered riders who have officially entered the race on motorcycles that have passed tech inspection for the event may ride, practice, or compete on any portion of the course on the day of the event.
8. Riders and/or family and pit crew who direct foul and abusive language to any official of the event are subject to disqualification of the entire event, and possibly future events. Each rider is responsible for the actions of his/her family and pit crew, and any detrimental action by these individuals puts the rider at risk for disqualification.
9. The minimum age for the Lightweight Class is 12 years of age. Riders competing on motorcycles over 250cc must be 14 years of age or older. The age of the rider is determined as of the date of the event.
10. The speed limit in the pit area is posted as WALKING SPEED. Any rider caught going faster than WALKING SPEED will be penalized 3 laps per incident. Two or more infractions of this rule will result in immediate disqualification.
11. All motorcycles must pass tech inspection prior to practice and must comply with all rules prior to being allowed on the course at any time. Event Director decisions are final.

12. (4) Four classes will run simultaneously:

- Lightweight Class: 125cc - 200cc;
- Middleweight Class: 201cc - 400cc;
- Heavyweight Class: 401cc - 1200cc;
- Ironman Class: 125cc - 1200cc.

**NOTE: TEAMS CANNOT HAVE MORE THAN 4 RIDERS**

13. Screws with a hexagonal head and a single screwdriver slot are permitted. These must be screwed into the tire from the outside and not protrude more than 3/16" from the outer edge of the tire. No screw modifications are allowed. AMA and Canadian type screws are acceptable.

14. Tire cutting, re-grooving or profiling are not permitted.

15. All bikes must have protective front and rear fenders.

a) Front fenders must extend from the fork legs, down around the tire, to a height no higher than the front axle.

b) Rear fenders must extend from a point on the rear tire that is vertical from the rear axle, down around the tire, to a height no higher than the rear axle.

c) The maximum allowed distance between fender and tire is 1.5 inches .

d) Fenders must be on at all times during the event. Any bike seen with a fender that no longer conforms to the requirements outlined will be black flagged. The bike may re-enter the course once the fender requirement is satisfied to conform to the requirements outlined above.

16. All motorcycles must have a muffler. Please note: The Wake the Monster Benefit event takes place on a public lake, and we must respect public property, our neighbors, noise levels if we expect to be allowed to continue.

17. Any team/rider seen leaving the course, only to re-enter the race intentionally cutting the course will be penalized 2 laps.

18. All engines must be shut off during refueling. Any team in violation of this rule will be penalized 3 laps.
19. Participants must use the same motorcycle for the duration of the race; furthermore, this motorcycle must be the one that passes tech inspection for the respective team. Teams or riders who change bikes during the event will be disqualified immediately with no refund.
20. All participants must attend the mandatory riders held prior to the start of the race or called throughout the event.
21. No pit riding of any kind will be permitted.
22. Protests must be made in writing by a participating rider, registered to compete in the event. Protest must be filed with Hooligan Racing within 30 minutes after the final results have been posted. A protest fee of \$500 must accompany the protest.
23. Event Officials may act on any issue concerning safety at any time.
24. This Rule Book may be amended or adjusted at any time as situations arise.
25. The AMA Rule Book will be used to supplement this rule book.

### **INDEMNITY RELEASE**
